1/2 Yard Carolina Cities, Red
[1] Fat Eight Carolina Cities, Blue
[1] Fat Quarter Carolina Cities, Green
1/8 yard Carolina Cities, Yellow
5/8 yard Carolinas Agriculture, Aqua
1/4 yard Carolinas Agriculture, Green
1/4 yard Carolinas Agriculture, Peach
[1] Fat Quarter Carolinas Agriculture, Pink
3-5/8 yard Carolinas Agriculture, Navy
Creative Grids Two Peaks in One Ruler

*Seams are 1/4" unless otherwise specified.
Fabric is directional, read all directions prior to cutting. Starch and Iron all fabric prior to cutting.
WOF - Width of fabric*

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

From ACSH Panel

Cut out Carolina Flag $23\frac{1}{4}" \times 22\frac{1}{4}"$
Cut out SC Flag and NC Flag $9\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$
Cut out Birds [2], Flowers [2] $7\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{3}{4}"$
(1/4" out from inside border)

From Carolina Cities, Red


Cut [1] strip $5\frac{1}{2}" \times \text{WOF}$
Subcut [4] triangles using the Creative Grids
Two Peaks in One Ruler
Cut [1] strip $6\frac{3}{4}" \times \text{WOF}$ (fabric is directional)
Subcut [1] $6\frac{3}{4}" \times 5\frac{1}{2}"$
Subcut [2] $6\frac{3}{4}" \times 7\frac{1}{2}"$
Subcut [1] $5\frac{1}{2}" \times 7\frac{1}{2}"$
Cut [4] strips $1\frac{1}{2}" \times \text{WOF}$
Subcut [2] $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 25\frac{1}{4}"$ (Top & Bottom)
Subcut [2] $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 22\frac{1}{2}"$ (Sides)

From Carolina Cities, Blue (fat eight)

Fabric is directional
Cut [1] $7\frac{1}{2}" \times 7\frac{1}{2}"$
Cut [1] $7\frac{1}{2}" \times 3\frac{1}{2}"$


From Carolina Agricultural, Peach

Cut fabric in half on the fold. Use [1] $9" \times 22"$ side
Cut [1] $5\frac{1}{2}"$ strip length of fabric
Subcut [4] triangles using the Creative Grids
Two Peaks Ruler




From 2nd piece of $9" \times 22"$ piece:

Cut [1] $7\frac{1}{2}" \times 7\frac{1}{2}"$
Cut [1] $7\frac{1}{2}" \times 3\frac{1}{2}"$
Cut [1] $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 11\frac{3}{4}"$



From Carolina Agricultural, Pink

Cut [1] strip $5\frac{1}{2}" \times 22"$
Subcut [4] triangles using the Creative Grids
Twin Peaks Ruler
Cut [1] $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 22"$
Subcut [1] $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 11\frac{3}{4}"$
Subcut [1] $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 7\frac{1}{2}"$
Cut [1] $9\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$
Cut [1] $7\frac{1}{2}" \times 7\frac{1}{2}"$




From Carolina Cities, Green

Cut [1] strip $5\frac{1}{2}" \times 22"$

Subcut [4] triangles using the Creative Grids
Twin Peaks Ruler

Cut [1] $9\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$

Cut [1] $7\frac{1}{2}" \times 12"$



From Carolina Agriculture, Aqua

Cut [1] strip $5\frac{1}{2}" \times \text{WOF}$

Subcut [4] triangles using the Creative Grids
Two Peaks in One Ruler

Cut [2] strips $3\frac{1}{8}" \times \text{WOF}$

Subcut [2] $24\frac{1}{2}" \times 3\frac{1}{8}"$

Cut [2] strips $2\frac{1}{2}" \times \text{WOF}$

Subcut [2] $30\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$

From Carolina Agriculture, Green

Cut [1] $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 11\frac{3}{4}"$

Cut [1] $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 10\frac{1}{2}"$

From Carolina Cities, Yellow

Cut [1] $1" \times \text{WOF}$

Subcut [4] $1" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$

Subcut [4] $1" \times 10\frac{1}{2}"$

From Carolina Agriculture, Navy

Cut [4] $3\frac{1}{2}" \times \text{WOF}$

Subcut [4] $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 30\frac{1}{2}"$

Subcut [4] $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 7\frac{1}{2}"$

Cut [4] $3\frac{1}{2}" \times \text{WOF}$

Subcut [4] $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 24\frac{3}{4}"$

Subcut [2] $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 11\frac{3}{4}"$

Subcut [1] $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 9\frac{1}{2}"$

Subcut [1] $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 10\frac{1}{2}"$

Cut [18] $3\frac{1}{2}" \times \text{WOF}$ for border

Subcut [2] $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 68\frac{3}{4}"$

Subcut [3] $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 64\frac{1}{2}"$

Cut [1] $3\frac{1}{2}" \times \text{WOF}$

Subcut [5] $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 7\frac{1}{2}"$

Cut [1] $3\frac{1}{2}" \times \text{WOF}$

Subcut [1] $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 17\frac{1}{2}"$

Subcut [1] $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 5\frac{1}{2}"$

Subcut [1] $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 15\frac{1}{2}"$

Cut [1] $3\frac{1}{2}" \times \text{WOF}$

Subcut [1] $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{3}{4}"$

Subcut [1] $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 16\frac{1}{2}"$

Cut [1] $5\frac{1}{2}" \times \text{WOF}$

Half triangles using the Creative Grids Twin
Peaks Ruler

Cut [8] $2\frac{1}{2}" \times \text{WOF}$

Sew all strips together for binding.

BLOCK BORDER ASSEMBLY:

Add Red borders to Carolina's map:

1. Place borders on right and left sides.
Pin border to each end of map make map fit
borders. Ease in fabric if needed.
2. Press.
3. Sew top and bottom border. Pin to each side
and center. Ease in fabric if needed.
4. Finished size should be $25\frac{1}{4}" \times 24\frac{1}{2}"$

Add Aqua borders to Carolina's map:

1. Place borders on right and left sides.
Pin border to each end of map and center.
Ease in fabric if needed.
2. Press.
3. Sew top and bottom border. Pin to each side
and center. Ease in fabric if needed.
4. Finished size should be $28\frac{1}{2}" \times 30\frac{1}{2}"$

Add Yellow borders to flags:


1. Place borders on right and left sides.
Pin borders to each end of map and center.
Ease in fabric if needed.
2. Press.
3. Sew top and bottom border. Pin to each side
and center. Ease in fabric if needed.
4. Finished size should be $10\frac{1}{2}" \times 7\frac{1}{2}"$ for
both South Carolina and North Carolina flag.

MAKING THE TRIANGLES:

1. Follow the directions on the Creative Grid ruler to create 5" finished size using 5-1/2" strips or watch the following video <https://youtu.be/3-lrP-Vzu9g>
2. When you have completed cutting all triangle units, sew together the rows in the following order:

Green, Orange, Red, Red, Aqua, Pink Triangle Rows

1. Sew orange point to the base of the green triangle unit, sew the red point to the base of the orange triangle unit. Sew [2] sets.
2. Sew aqua point to the base of the pink triangle, sew the red point of the triangle to the base of the aqua triangle. Sew [2] sets.
3. When completed sew the bases of the red triangles together. You should have a row measuring 30-1/2" x 5-1/2". Sew [2] sets.



Pink, Peach, Green Triangle Row

1. Sew orange point to base of pink, sew green point to base of orange triangle. Sew [2] sets.



QUILT BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

1. Using the 7-1/2" x 3-1/2" navy agriculture strips, join the blue cities 7-1/2" x 7-1/2" square, the North Carolina flag 10-1/2" x 7-1/2" and the peach agriculture 7-1/2" x 7-1/2" together.



2. Sew a 30-1/2" strip of navy agriculture to the completed row.
3. Sew a green, orange, red, red, aqua, pink triangle row to the bottom of the 30-1/2" strip.

4. Sew a 30-1/2" strip of navy agriculture to the bottom of the triangle row
5. Sew the Carolinas map to the bottom of the triangle row.
6. Sew a 30-1/2" strip of navy agriculture to the bottom of the map.
7. Sew a pink, aqua, red, red, orange green triangle row to the bottom of the 30-1/2" strip
8. Sew a 30-1/2" strip of navy agriculture to the bottom of the triangle row.



9. Using the 7-1/2" x 3-1/2" navy agriculture strips, join the red cities 7-1/2" x 6-3/4" square, the yellow flower 7-1/2" x 6-3/4" and the green cities 7-1/2" x 12" together.



10. Using triangle row pink, peach and green triangle, sew a 15-1/2" x 3-1/2" navy agriculture to the bottom. Pin sides together at top and bottom and ease in any difference.



11. Connect a green city 9-1/2" x 6-1/2" to a 9-1/2" x 3-1/2" navy agriculture. Connect those [2] blocks to a 9-1/2" x 6-1/2" pink agriculture. Pin sides together at top and bottom and ease in any difference. Connect the [2] blocks.




12. Connect the 17-1/2" × 3-1/2" navy agriculture block to the green and pink side.
13. Connect the red cities 7-1/2" × 6-3/4" block to the yellow 7-1/2" × 6-3/4" flower block with a 3-1/2" × 7-1/2" navy agricultural block. Sew completed block to larger block.



14. Connect the bird, pink, 7-1/2" × 3-1/2", orange 7-1/2" × 3-1/2" and blue cities 7-1/2" × 3-1/2" blocks using the navy agricultural 7-1/2" × 3-1/2" blocks. In the order as shown. Connect a 24-3/4" × 3-1/2" block to the bottom of the completed block.



15. Connect a triangle block to the red cities 5-1/2" × 6-3/4" block using a 5-1/2" × 3-1/2" navy agricultural block. Connect a 24-3/4" × 3-1/2" block to the bottom of the completed block. Connect all the block to the bottom of the block sewn prior.



16. Connect the South Carolina flag to the green agricultural 6-1/2" × 10-1/2" block using a 3-1/2" × 10-1/2" navy agricultural block. Then attach navy agricultural 16-1/2" × 3-1/2" block to the right side of that block. Attach the green agricultural 3-1/2" × 11-3/4", orange 4-1/2" × 11-3/4" and pink 3-1/2" × 11-3/4", blocks together using 3-1/2" × 11-3/4" navy agricultural blocks. Connect a 3-1/2" × 24-3/4" navy agricultural block to the bottom of the completed block.



17. Connect the agricultural pink 7-1/2" × 7-1/2", red cities 7-1/2" × 5-1/2" and the white flower 7-1/2" × 6-3/4" together using navy agricultural 7-1/2" × 3-1/2" blocks. Connect to the above block.



18. Connect the two sides together.
19. Sew together [2] 3-1/2" strips.
20. Pin the strip to the top and bottom of the left side panel easing in any extra fabric. Sew together.
21. Pin the strip to the top and bottom of the right side panel easing in any extra fabric. Sew together.



BORDER ASSEMBLY

1st Border

1. Sew together [2] 40" × 3-1/2" strips of navy agriculture.
2. Cut [2] 64-1/2" × 3-1/2".
3. Pin to quilt right and left side making sure to line up fabric at both top and bottom, easing in any extra fabric.
4. Cut [2] 63-3/4" × 3-1/2".
5. Pin to quilt top and bottom making sure to line up fabric at both ends, easing in any extra fabric.

2nd Border

1. From all leftover fabric, cut [68] 1-1/2" × 4-1/2" rectangles and [4] 1-1/2" red cities squares.

2. Sew together [2] rows of [16] blocks, sewing together the 1-1/2" ends, finished size should be 64-1/2" × 1-1/2".
3. Sew to the right and left sides of the quilt easing in any extra fabric.
4. Sew together [2] rows of [16] blocks for top and bottom of quilt prior to attaching add 1-1/2" squares to both the right and left side, these are your corner stones. Top and bottom borders should finish at 66-1/2" × 1-1/2" with corner stones attached.
5. Sew to top and bottom of quilt easing in any extra fabric.

3rd Border

1. Sew together [2] 40" × 3-1/2" strips of navy agriculture.
2. Measure quilt vertically, cut [2] borders to fit.
3. Pin to quilt right and left side making sure to line up fabric at both top and bottom, easing in any extra fabric.
4. Measure quilt horizontally, cut [2] borders to fit.
5. Pin to quilt top and bottom making sure to line up fabric at both ends, easing in any extra fabric.
