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Basic Sunglass

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Designed by Crystal, Brooklynn, and Daytonna Drummond Let's Quilt Along & DayBrook Designs

MATERIALS:

1/4 yard of your favorite ACSH fabric 1/4 yard Fusible Fleece

RECOMMENDED TOOLS:

Creative Grids Ruler: 8-1/2" Square

READ THROUGH ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING. USE A 1/4" SEAM ALLOWANCE UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED. SEW FABRICS RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

From ACSH Fabric:

Cut [2] - 8-1/2" squares for the Exterior and Lining of the Sunglass Case Optional: Cut [1] $3'' \times 6''$ for the loop

From Fusible Fleece:

Cut [1] - 7-1/2" square

OPTIONAL: LOOP ASSEMBLY:

Creating a loop is similar to making double-fold bias tape.

- 1. Fold fabric in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Press.
- 2. Open and place the raw edges to meet in the middle crease. Press.
- 3. Close fabric as in step 1. Press.
- 4. Topstitch along both long sides to secure.

ASSEMBLY:

- 1. According to Fusible Fleece instructions, adhere to wrong side of exterior fabric.
- 2. If desired, machine quilt.
- Fold loop in half with raw edges together. Position at top center of exterior square, with loop facing toward the center of the square. Stitch 1/8" from edge to secure loop to exterior.
- 4. Place exterior RST with lining. Pin around all sides. Leave a 2" opening on the bottom for turning.
- 5. Sew around all sides except opening.
- 6. Clip corners to reduce bulk. If making the curved case, clip the curves.
- 7. Turn project right side out. Check corners to ensure fabric is laid smoothly. Press.
- 8. Topstitch 1/8" from top edge.
- 9. Fold horizontally so lining side is inside.
- 10. Topstitch seam side and bottom to secure.
