MATERIALS:

Materials listed provides enough fabric to complete both quilts. If you only want to make 1 quilt, you will need that panel, 1/2 yard each of Icons Cream and Icons Blue, and 1/4 yard of each fabric for stripes.

- 1/2 yard Blender Clouds **(A)**
- 1 North Carolina Panel **(B1)**
- 1 South Carolina Panel **(B2)**
- 1/2 yard Blender Trees **(C)**
- 1/4 yard Blossoms White **(D1)**
- 1/4 yard Blossoms Yellow **(D2)**
- 1/2 yard Shells Cream **(E)**
- 1/2 yard Blender Sand **(F)**
- 1/2 yard Blender Waves **(G)**
- 2 Carolinas Scenes Panels **(H)**
- 1 yard Carolina Icons Cream **(I)**
- 1 yard Carolina Icons Blue **(J)**
- 8 yards Backing (4 yards per quilt)
- 1 yard Binding

BEFORE SEWING, READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS. ALL SEAMS ARE 1/4" UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED. CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS ARE BASED ON 40" WOF. WOF = WIDTH OF FABRIC; RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER

CUTTING:

From Blender Clouds Fabric:

Cut [2] — 7-1/4" × 36" strips **(A)**

From both North Carolina **(B1)** and South Carolina Panels **(B2):**

Trim off both top and bottom rows of scenes to measure 36" × 26"

From Blender Trees Fabric:

Cut [2] — 7-1/4" × 36" strips **(C)**

From Blossoms White Fabric:

Cut [1] — 7-1/4" × 36" strip **(D1)**

From Blossoms Yellow Fabric:

Cut [1] — 7-1/4" × 36" strip **(D2)**

From Shells Cream Fabric:

Cut [2] — 7-1/4" × 36" strips **(E)**

From Blender Sand Fabric:

Cut [2] — 7-1/4" × 36" strips **(F)**

From Blender Waves Fabric:

Cut [2] — 7-1/4" × 36" strips **(G)**

From Icons Cream Fabric:

Cut [14] — 2-1/2" × WOF strips **(I)**

From Icons Blue Fabric:

Cut [14] — 2-1/2" × WOF strips **(J)**

From Carolinas Scenes Panel:

Cut your choice of [2] Columns (5 scenes) and [2] Columns (4 scenes). The columns will be cut 7-1/8" wide that will include the image and 1/2" past the left and right edges. See detailed images in assembly instructions.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

Carolina Scenes Border:

This part offers the option to use any collection of scenes from this panel by following the steps below:

1. Cut [2] columns of [5] Scenes with 1/2" Blue border on the left and right sides of the images. This should be a total width of 7-1/8".
2. Cut [2] columns of [4] Scenes with 1/2" Blue border on the left and right sides of the images. To obtain the overall length needed for this project, you will want to take a 5-scene column and then remove the top scene by cutting at the bottom of that top scene in order to retain all the blue border between the top and second scene in the column as shown.
3. Take one 4-Scene column sew it to the bottom of one 5-Scene column. Press and check the over length of the column. It should be about 66-1/4". Repeat for 2nd set of columns.
4. Repeat Steps 1-3 for the second quilt.



QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY:

Follow this guide to sort your fabric pieces before assembly:

1. Sew the 36" strips along the long edge in the following order:

North Carolina:

Blender Clouds **(A)**

North Carolina Panel **(B1)**

Blender Trees **(C)**

Blossoms White **(D1)**

Shells Cream **(E)**

Blender Sand **(F)**

Blender Waves **(G)**

2. Press top. Size should be 36" × 66-1/2".



3. **South Carolina:**

Blender Clouds **(A)**

South Carolina Panel **(B2)**

Blender Trees **(C)**

Blossoms Yellow **(D2)**

Shells Cream **(E)**

Blender Sand **(F)**

Blender Waves **(G)**

4. Press top. Size should be 36" × 66-1/2".



5. Attach the Scene Columns previously assembled onto the left and right of the quilt body.
6. Press the new seams. Finish size should be 49-1/4" × 66-1/2".

BORDER ASSEMBLY:

1. Sew [7] of the Carolina Icons Blue **(J)** strips together end-to-end. Make one set for each quilt.
2. Measure the outer left edge of the quilt top and cut one piece of Carolina Icons Blue **(J)** strip to that length. Sew onto the left edge of the quilt top.
3. Repeat Steps 1 and 2 to complete the right side of the quilt top. Measure the width and cut [2] strips for top and bottom. Sew to quilt.
4. Sew [7] of the Carolina Icons Cream **(I)** strips together end-to-end. Make one set for each quilt.
5. Repeat the above process to attach the Icons Cream border.

FINISHING:

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
5. Label & Enjoy!
